LCCS Receives \$100,000 Grant from Amon G. Carter Foundation

The Amon G. Carter Foundation, long known for its philanthropy in the Fort Worth community, has given a \$100,000 grant to Lake Country Christian School in support of completing the new LCCS Athletic Complex. The 56,000 square foot facility, which is currently more than 90% complete, will expand the school's athletic facilities while relieving scheduling issues in the school's current gym/auditorium. "We are grateful to the Foundation," commented LCCS Director of Development Sue Bradle, "for their support to assist in completing this multi-purpose facility."

The Amon G. Carter Foundation has supported Lake Country Christian in the past through a grant that helped fund renovations to create the current high school. In addition, the school sits on property that is formerly part of the original Amon Carter farm.

The LCCS sports program includes state- and district-level wins and recognition for several teams. The LCCS Girls Basketball Team won state last year, and has been in the state play-offs three out of the last four years. The LCCS Boys Basketball Team won state three years ago. Over the last five years, LCCS student athletes have received recognition on all-district and all-state teams and been chosen for Dale Hansen's Athletes as well as the Star-Telegram Private School teams. The LCCS football program, having just completed its first varsity year, had six students named to the all-district team, while three girls were named to the all-district volleyball team.

Lake Country Christian School is a Prek-12, college prep, Christ-centered school located at 8777 Boat Club Road in northwest Fort Worth.
